ADAMS WAS INFORMED BY CONTROL-4 OPERATOR THAT THE DORM WAS HOLLERING AND ACTING UP. I LT. ADAMS AND CAPT. WILLIAM BELL REVIEWED THE CAMERAS TO SEE IF THERE HAD BEEN ANY FIGHTS HAPPEN. AFTER REVIEWING THE CAMERAS IN I-DORM, I LT. ADAMS SEEN THERE HAD BEEN A FIGHT BETWEEN OFFENDER S AND OFFENDER J. IT SHOWS ON CAMERA OFFENDER P HIT OFFENDER J. WITH WHAT APPEARS TO BE GRATING FROM THE SHOWER AREA, WHILE OFFENDER JONES WAS STABBING OFFENDER PEPE WITH WHAT APPEARS TO BE AN IMPROVISED WEAPON (SHANK). THIS PLACES BOTH OFFENDERS IN VIOLATION OF RULE #11 (AGGRAVATED FIGHTING). I LT. ADAMS AND CAPT. BELL THEN WENT INTO I-DORM AND ESCORTED OFFENDER P AND OFFENDER J OUT OF THE DORM TO MEDICAL. OFFENDER J WAS CLEARED BY MEDICAL AND ESCORTED TO CELL-6 TO AWAIT DISCIPLINARY ACTION. OFFENDER F WAS TRANSPORTED TO LASALLE GENERAL HOSPITAL AT 20:12. 
Title: INCIDENT/ARREST REPORT

On 05/13/2024, Catahoula Correctional Center reported that they had a fight at the prison between two inmates. During the fight, one inmate was struck with some type of iron grating and the other was stabbed with a "prison shank".

During the investigation of the incident, I retrieved video footage that showed the two inmates, identified as S and D, fighting in the dorm. The two stop fighting on their own and separate. Shortly thereafter, it shows J approaching F again. When J gets close to P, P swings what appeared to be a pillow case at J, hitting him. When contact is made, a piece of metal grating falls out and slid across the floor. J then immediately began stabbing P with a "prison shank". P was transported to LaSalle General for medical treatment. (See medical notes).

At this time, I prepared arrest affidavits and arrest warrants for both P and J. I then presented them to Judge Kathy Johnson for review. After review, she signed the warrants ordering their arrest.

On 6/11/24, both P and J were arrested at Catahoula Correction Center and booked for the charge of Aggravated Battery.
