On 06/25/2024 at approximately 2234 hours, I, Deputy William Beason, responded to Control four(4) for a possible drug use in I-dorm. Arriving in control 4, I reviewed the camera's and seen Inmates Darryl Arceneuax(DOC#259864), Tanner Simmons(DOC#407831), Bijan Rashidi(DOC#784031), and Tyler Guillory(DOC#630908) doing what appeared to be snorting a white substance. Lieutenant Jeremy Dudley, Captain Cory Whittington and Myself, then went into I-Dorm to escort the inmate's that were caught on camera out of the dorm for a strip search. During the strip search, Inmate Guillory was trying to drop a little bag of white/clear substance wrapped in saran wrap between the microwave stand and the wall inside the interlock. We then escorted everyone outside along the wall for more room to strip search. At this time, Lt. Dudley and Myself, saw Inmate Guillory pass a piece of his clothing to another offender. Lt. Dudley then recovered the underwear and recovered two(2) small packages wrapped in saran wrap from inside the underwear and turned the evidence over to me to hold on to. We then escorted the inmates to the booking block to be drug tested. Cpt. Whittington, Lt. Dudley, and Myself, then went inside booking to take pictures and to open the packages to see what was contained inside. During the opening of the packages, package number one(1) contained what appeared to be twenty-five(25) sheets(small various sizes of rectangular pieces of paper) of suspected synthetic marijuana. Package number two(2) contained what appeared to be suspected methamphetamines(crystal meth) weight approximately 14 grams with the bag it was contained in. Signed and filled out, we then placed the evidence inside clear ziploc bags then placed both bags in to one evidence bag and we sealed the evidence bag. The evidence bag was then turned over from Catahoula Corrections per Assistant Warden Gary Allen into my custody when leaving the facility. The evidenced bag was then taken to Catahoula Parish Sheriff's Office where I placed the evidence into the narcotics lockbox and filled out in the log book being turned over to narcotics.

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND APPROXIMATE TIME, I LT. JEREMY DUDLEY WAS NOTIFIED BY CONTROL 4 THAT SHE HAD SEEN INMATES DARRYL ARCENEUX (259864), TANNER SIMMONS (407831), BIJAN RASHIDI (784031) AND TYLER GUILLORY (630908) IN I-DORM SNORTING AN UNKNOWN SUBSTANCE. MYSELF CAPTAIN CORY WHITTINGTON AND DEPUTY WILLIAM BEASON RESPONDED TO THE DORM AND ESCORTED THE INMATES OUTSIDE AND PERFORMED A STRIP SEARCH ON THEM. AT THIS POINT TYLER GUILLORY WAS FOUND TO HAVE ON HIS PERSON A LARGE BAG OF SUSPECTED METHAMPHETAMINES AND ALSO A SMALLER BAG CONTAINING THE SAME. THE LARGER OF THE BAGS WEIGHED OUT TO BE 13.8 GRAMS, AND THE SMALLER WEIGHED 0.3 GRAMS. TYLER GUILLORY WAS ALSO FOUND TO BE IN POSSESSION OF 25 PIECES OF SUSPECTED SYNTHETIC MARIJUANA. ALL 4 INMATES WERE THEN ESCORTED TO MEDICAL WHERE THEY WERE ASKED TO SUBMIT A URINE SAMPLE FOR TESTING. INMATES ARCENEUX, SIMMONS AND GUILLORY ALL HAD A NON NEGATIVE RESULT FOR METHAMPHETAMINES ON A 5 PANEL INSTANT DRUG SCREEN CUP. AT THIS TIME L.P.N. MARLEE ROARK THEN USED A ONE PANEL INSTANT DRUG SCREEN TO GET CONFIRMATION ON THE INITIAL RESULT. AGAIN ALL 3 INMATES ARCENEUX, SIMMONS AND GUILLORY ALL SHOWED NON NEGATIVE RESULTS FOR METHAMPHETAMINES ON THE ONE PANEL DRUG SCREEN. AT THIS TIME INMATE ARCENEUX WAS PLACED INTO CELL 9, INMATE SIMMONS WAS PLACED INTO CELL 8 AND INMATE GUILLORY WAS PLACED INTO CELL 6 FOR A VIOLATION OF RULE #1 CONTRABAND. ALL ARE AWAITING DISCIPLINARY ACTION. E.O.R.

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND APPROXIMATE TIME, I CPT. CORY WHITTINGTON RESPONDED TO A CALL FROM CONTROL 4 STATING THAT FOUR INMATES WAS STANDING BESIDE A BUNK SNORTING A UNKNOWN WHITE SUBSTANCE. UPON REVIEWING THE CAMERAS, I CPT. WHITTINGTON THEN WITNESSED INMATES TANNER SIMMONS (407831), DARRYL ARCENEUX (259864), TYLER GUILLORY (630908) AND BIJAN RASHIDI (748031) STANDING NEXT TO THE BUNK AND SNORTING A UNKNOWN WHITE SUBSTANCE AS THE CONTROL 4 OPERATOR WITNESSED AND DESCRIBED. UPON WITNESSING THIS INCIDENT INMATES SIMMONS, ARCENEUX, GUILLORY AND RASHIDI WAS ESCORTED OUT OF I-DORM AND STRIP SEARCHED. LT. JEREMY DUDLEY AND DEPUTY WILLIAM BEASON THEN FOUND 1 BAG OF WHAT WAS SUSPECTED TO BE METHAMPHETAMINES (CYRSTAL METH AND TWO BAGS OF AN UNKNOWN SUBSTANCE WRAPPED IN SARAN WRAP ON INMATE TYLER GUILLORY'S PERSON. IT WAS LATER DISCOVERED BY DEPUTY BEASON THAT THE TWO BAGS OF UNKNOWN SUBSTANCES ON INMATE GUILLORY'S PERSON WAS WHAT APPAREARED TO BE 25 SHEETS OF SUSPECTED SYNTHETIC MARIJUANA AND APPROXIMATELY 14 GRAMS OF WHAT WAS SUSPECTED TO BE METHAMPHETAMINES (CYRSTAL METH). INMATES SIMMONS, ARCENEUX AND RASHIDI'S STRIP SEARCH WAS CODE 4 (NOTHING FOUND ON PERSON). ALL 4 INMATES WAS THEN ESCORTED TO THE BOOKING BLOCK TO BE DRUG TESTED. INMATE SIMMONS WAS ISSUED A 5-PANEL DRUG SCREEN AND IT GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH, INMATE SIMMONS WAS THEN GIVEN A SECOND TEST SINGLE PANEL FOR METH BY THE ON-DUTY NURSE MARLEE ROARK AND IT ALSO GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH. INMATE GUILLORY WAS ISSUED A 5-PANEL DRUG SCREEN AND IT GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH, INMATE GUILLORY WAS THEN GIVEN A SECOND TEST SINGLE PANEL FOR METH BY THE ON-DUTY NURSE MARLEE ROARK AND IT ALSO GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH. INMATE ARCENEUX WAS ISSUED A 5-PANEL DRUG SCREEN AND IT GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH, INMATE ARCENEUX WAS THE GIVEN A SECOND TEST SINGLE PANEL FOR METH BY THE ON DUTY NURSE MARLEE ROARK AND IT ALSO GAVE A NON-NEGATIVE READING FOR METH. INMATE RASHIDI WAS GIVEN A 5-PANEL DRUG SCREEN AND IT GAVE A NON-POSITIVE READING, INMATE RASHIDI WAS PLACED BACK INTO I-DORM. THIS ACTION PUTS INMATES GUILLORY, ARCENEUX AND SIMMONS IN VIOLATION OF RULE #1 CONTRABAND. INMATE SIMMONS WAS PLACED INTO CELL-8 TO AWAIT DISCIPLINARY ACTION, INMATE GUILLORY WAS PLACED INTO CELL-6 TO AWAIT DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND INMATE ARCENEUX WAS PLACED INTO CELL-9 TO AWAIT DISCIPLINARY ACTION. 
On 6/25/2024, the Catahoula Sheriffs office recieved a call from the Catahoula Correctional Facility reporting that they had recovered suspected narcotics from an inmate at the facility.

Upon investigation, it was learned that correctional officers witnessed the suspect, inmate Tyler Guillory and other inmates snorting a substance in I-dorm. Ofc. Beason, Lt. Jeremy Dudley and Capt. Cory Whittington then entered the dorm and removed all suspects into the dorms interlock for a strip search. During the strip search, officers witnessed Guillory drop a bag of white substance between the microwave and wall. They then moved all the inmates out of the interlock, onto the wall so they had more room to search. When doing so, they witnessed Guillory trying to pass an article of clothing to one of the other inmates. Lt. Dudley retrieved the underwear that was passed and recovered two (2) small packages wrapped in saran wrap inside the underwear. All evidence was retrieved and secured.

Once the inmates were placed on the booking block, officers began opening the retrieved evidence. The initial evidence that was dropped behind the microwave was determined to be 25 sheets of suspected synthetic marijuana. The two packages found in the underwear, where determined to be suspected methamphetamine (approx 14 grams). All evidence was secured in evidence bags.

At this time, arrest affidavits and warrants were prepared for the arrest of Guillory for possession of Sch II CDS and Possession of Sch I CDS (synthetic Marijuana). The documents were submitted to Judge John Reeves for review. After review, Judge Reeves signed the warrants, ordering the arrest of Guillory.

On 7/18/24, Guillory was arrested on the above charges. He was transported from Catahoula Corrections to Catahoula SO, where he was booked on the charges of Possession of Sch II CDS (Meth) and Possession of Sch I CDs (MOJO). Once the booking was competed, he was transfered back to CCC to await prosecution.
